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### Barolo Comune di Barolo, Anselma 2022

From vineyard plots across the sub-region of Barolo, fermented with a proportion of whole bunches using natural yeasts and aged for two to three years in 10 to 50hl old Slavonian casks, this has an expressive style and immediate appeal. Sour cherry and rhubarb lead on the nose, with a little spice and black tea developing in the glass. The palate shows orange peel brightness and sweet-cherry charm, carried by fine structure. An elegant Barolo that, if decanted, could be enjoyed on release. Drink from 2026 to 2032. 13.5%

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### Barolo del Comune di La Morra, Ciabot Berton 2022

From two vineyards with a little more sand in the soils, the idea of Ciabot Berton's Comune di La Morra is to be open and accessible, to capture La Morra's easy-going spirit. This is effortlessly achieved by fifth-generation winegrower Marco in this warm, intense vintage. It has immediate appeal, with red-berry and orange-citrus aromas, and a sweet mid-palate of raspberry and sour cherry. Brightly fruited with gentle, sandy-textured tannins, this is - as ever - an absolute delight (and a real bargain, too). Drink from 2026 to 2036. 14%

## Barolo del Comune di Verduno, Cascina Massara 2022

With characteristic Verduno perfume and expressiveness, Massara's commune bottling (from three parcels including the Massara cru) is particularly compelling in 2022. The nose shows aromas of dried rose petal, cherry and red apple, lifted by aniseed and orange zest. The palate is fresh and vibrant, the fruit carrying a gentle sweetness, while fine, chalky tannins frame a long, precise finish. Drink from 2026 to 2034. 14.5%

## Barolo Le Coste di Monforte, Silvano Bolmida 2022

An elegant yet powerful 2022 rendition of Le Coste di Monforte, which is at the very southern limit of the Barolo DOCG, facing Ginestra to the north and Francia in Serralunga to the east. Wonderfully aromatic with blood orange, black tea and savoury broth notes, combining with black plums and dark berries. Firm, mineral tannins have a mouthcoating effect, enclosing the bramble and citrus fruit. The freshness that balances this fruit – thanks to the 470m elevation of the vines – is captivating, with juicy, bright acidity perfectly integrated into the body of the wine. Drink from 2026 to 2034. 14.5%

## Barolo Pio, Pio Cesare 2022

'Pio' is a blend of nine vineyards from five of Barolo's communes – though built on Serralunga d'Alba and Monforte d'Alba, including the great crus of Ornato and Mosconi – giving us a snapshot of the region. With benchmark aromas of dried rose petals and orange peel, red plums and cherry, it is simultaneously elegant and powerful, with prominent tannins which are robust yet fine. The mid-palate is already silky and finishes with a moreish sapidity and pinpoint balance. Produced in the same way and with the same maturation regime as both the single vineyards from Pio Cesare; as Cesare Benvenuto would say, this is not their 'regular' Barolo – this is their flagship wine. Drink from 2026 to 2038. 14.5%

## Barolo del Comune di Serralunga d'Alba, Schiavenza 2022

The commune bottling blends Cerrati, Meriame, the lower, more fertile part of Broglio and a small, west-facing parcel in Cerretta. In 2022 the nose remains floral and earthy, very Serralunga in style, but with a riper, warmer profile of dark cherry, dried herbs and iron-rich earth. The palate is more open-knit and approachable, with supple red and black cherry fruit and a gentle blood orange lift. Tannins are firm but support the fruit pulling through on the finish well. Drink from 2026 to 2036. 14.5%
