Wine & Dine is back, and this time we've picked the perfect bottles to pair with some of the seasonal springtime ingredients we love this time of year.

A SEASONAL ROAST

A lighter-style roast enjoyed with seasonal veg and fresh flavours is what springtime Sundays are made for. Try roast chicken packed with punchy garlic alongside a glass of **Timorasso, Boveri Luigi 2023**. This Italian white has immediate intensity on the palate of white and yellow peach, orchard fruit and Alpine herbs. With a salty freshness on the long finish, this is an ideal springtime sip. If roast lamb is on the menu, we'd pair it with the concentrated and well-balanced **Château de la Grave 'Caractère', Côtes de Bourg 2021**. From the perfumed 2021 Bordeaux vintage, this red has a fragrant bouquet of plums, tar and vanilla, with a layered, juicy texture on the palate and grainy, ripe tannins on the finish.



ALL ABOUT ASPARAGUS

Typically in season from April to June, nothing says spring has sprung quite like asparagus. Baked into a Gruyère quiche is a tasty way to celebrate its earthy goodness, but it's equally delicious oven-cooked or sautéed. We'd match the crisp **Chignin Vers Les Alpes, Jean-François Quénard 2024** with this hardy springtime staple. Light and fresh, this Savoie white combines finesse with plenty of citrus and steeliness alongside tangy acidity. A glass of this would also pair nicely with fondue and goat's cheese.









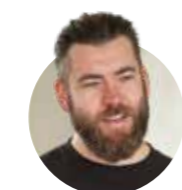

South AMERICA

These wines are all from relatively cool climates, such as high altitude vineyards above 950m in Argentina (Kipu and La Revancha) cool coastal vineyards in Chile or Uruguay (Matetic and Pisano) and a relatively cool climate for the late ripening carmenère, made by Clos de Luz in Almahue. These conditions give vibrant fruit flavours and a balanced palate, that makes for a moreish style of wine.

How to do it:

Serve chillable styles at no more than 16°C by cooling them down in the fridge for 20-30 minutes, or longer if needed. Otherwise, an ice bucket can be used to achieve cellar temperature: 10°C to 14°C.

Best-suited styles:

Beaujolais, pinot noir, cinsault and zweigelt to name a few.
