It all adds up to a selection of go-to bottles that will pair perfectly with crackling fires, sofa evenings and seasonal food. Explore them with confidence.

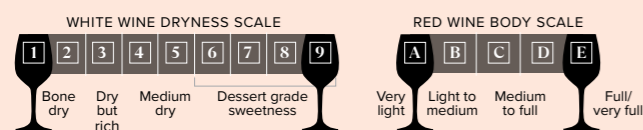





AUTUMN SPOTLIGHT

Cabernet Franc

It's official: cabernet franc is having a moment in the sun! Warmer vintages and gentler winemaking are conspiring to see this bright, often chillable and food-friendly grape soar in quality and consistency. These reds aren't heavy blockbusters at all, but their joyful nature and slightly earthy, food-friendly character make them an autumn party in a glass.

Coteaux du Quercy 630 Vignerons du Quercy Rouge 2023

Ripe, fruity southern French red, mainly cabernet franc with malbec, tannat and merlot in support. It's from a district very close to Cahors that makes wines in a similar vein to its more famous neighbour. Excellent value for money, this is an ideal match for the local cuisine such as duck confit.

Rich & Textured Whites

Colder weather doesn't automatically mean it's time for red wines! These rich, luxurious, foodie whites are a goldmine of indulgent ideas for when the leaves turn. The aromatic, apricotty viognier grape and the globetrotting charm of chenin blanc are well represented, but there are some more unusual discoveries to be found, too, such as Italy's timorasso grape and a brilliant Greek assyrtiko we welcomed to our range this year.

wine without fuss

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Harriet's Autumn Menu

With the perfect bottle to serve for each course!

CANAPÉ

Wild mushroom bruschetta with thyme, pine nuts, pecorino & torn buffalo mozzarella

I usually go for chanterelles and pied-de-moutons (hedgehog fungus) because I have my secret mushroom spots. But these days, farmers markets and even some supermarkets have a decent wild mushroom selection. Timing is everything here, too: make sure you don't soggy the bread by waiting too long to serve, and toast your slices just right, crispy but still with a little softness to the bite. Garlic and thyme sautéed mushrooms piled high are the star, but wait for the mushrooms to cool just a little before tearing on the mozzarella, otherwise it melts away too much. Enjoy with a fresh light, slightly earthy red – I love it with **Frappato, Costadune Mandrarossa 2024** (£12.25, IT43341) from Italy.

STARTER

Fresh taglioni with clams, chilli and sage

I love any excuse to include pasta in a menu: served as a primo piatto, it feels like a treat but keeps things light enough to save room for the main event. Fresh clams are key: source the best you can find (I like palourde as they are small, robust and delicious) and give them a good soak before cooking. Make sure your pasta is perfectly al dente, and well seasoned. Sage can be subbed for parsley if you prefer. For a great bottle to pair, I recommend **Maruxa Godello, Valdeorras 2024** (£12.50, SP21261). Textured yet light, this Spanish white won't overpower the clams, but has enough texture and body to carry the chilli and sage.

MAIN COURSE

Beef stew with suet dumplings

This is one of the dishes I genuinely look forward to most as autumn sets in. I also love this for a dinner party as you can do the bulk of work in advance. My mum used to make it with a giant suet dumpling 'lid', just one massive fluffy topping like a savoury duvet – so that's what I do. I'd also include kale in this, added nearer the time of serving: it's in season and adds a real mineral earthiness to the dish. This definitely calls for a wine with guts – I love Aussie shiraz and **Silver Lining Adelaide Hills Shiraz 2022** (£16, AU28021) is a fine example.

DESSERT

Classic apple crumble

You can't go wrong, you can prepare it in advance and it's a great excuse to get the pudding wines out! Always use cooking apples – Bramleys are the classic go-to because they soften up beautifully without turning mushy. I like to toss the apples with a bit of cinnamon and lemon juice to give that warming autumn vibe and a nice balance of sweet and tart. Add oats to the crumble for extra flavour and texture. **Coteaux du Layon Saint Aubin, Domaine Cady 2023** (£16, LO20251) works beautifully: delish and light, and not overly sweet, so it pairs well with the tartness of the apples.
