

REDS

The Society's Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2017

A ripe, friendly red for enjoying with all things Italian

This perennial member favourite has the deep purple colour and generous fruit of a hot vintage with low yields, yet buzzes with freshness and vitality that will transport a Friday night pizza to the Adriatic coast! 13.5%

'Dirt Track' Shiraz by Duncan Savage, Western Cape 2018

Spice and sweetness from South Africa's surfing superstar

Ride the Cape syrah wave with one of its most gifted and popular ambassadors. The chocolate-smooth sweet oak and spice vibe pampers pumpkins and squashes to perfection. 13.5%

Bodegas Murua Aclys Crianza, Rioja 2015

The mellowest of autumn reds

A neighbour of the famous Riscal, Murua holds some of Rioja's finest vineyards but is relatively unknown here. Relish the fleshy fruit and subtly smoky oak of this elegant and silky red with mature lamb, for a real taste of autumn. 14%

Weinert Carrascal Corte Clasico, Mendoza 2015

Startlingly original Argentine red, adored by claret fans

Lovely blend of malbec, cabernet sauvignon and merlot matured for about three years in large old foudres until the bright fruit flavours have mellowed and been transformed to gentle flavours of cedar, leather and tobacco. Drink now to 2039. 14.5%

The Society's Primitivo di Manduria 2017

Fruit and spice and all things nice

Master of primitivo (aka zinfandel) Gregory Perucci makes this for us from bush vines in the grape's Puglian heartland. Deep, brooding and velvety wine, perfect for a rich ragù of aubergines and peppers. Drink now to 2021. 14%

Brazin Lodi Old-Vine Zinfandel 2016

A bold American that means business

Does exactly what it says on the tin with a full-bodied hit of brambly fruit and notes of mocha that demand a big bowl of black bean chilli on Bonfire Night. Drink now to 2024. 14.5%

Ventoux, Les Cinq Puits 2016

Celebrity Rhône, with real star quality

Dust off your best daube recipe for this elegant red, infused with hints of figs and wild herbs that sing of its origins in the southern Rhône. Actress Keira Knightley and James Righton (of rock band The Klaxons) entrust the winemaking to Luc Guénard of neighbouring Château de Valcombe and we think this is the best vintage to date. Drink now to 2023. 14%

Heroic Spanish red to beat the autumn chill

This powerful but well-proportioned Ribera handles the richness of pork and duck while doing less formal duty with baked baby chorizos or any dish infused with smoked paprika. Drink this year and next. 14%

Outstandingly complex Chilean for enjoying with simple, sophisticated dinners

Cristobal Undurraga's astonishing blend of majority mourvèdre, for tobacco and leather characters, a third garnacha for rose-petal aromas and a healthy dash of carignan for freshness, structure and length is seasoned with a little splash of syrah. It all spends 18 months in barrel for roundness and a smooth texture.

Keep the food simple – steak and chips, for example. Drink now to 2027. 14.5%

Muscadet Sèvre-et-Maine sur Lie, Domaine des Ratelles 2018

The perfect all-rounder

Serious Muscadet doesn't stop with summer and beachside seafood feasts. Uncork the fresh, dry, stone-fruit charm of this Vinet family benchmark with spatchcocked chicken and oily fish, rubbed with herby oil and charred to perfection on the grill. 12%
